- o SH:
 - No regular exercise
 - smoker (15ys, 2PPD)
 - Positive Fhx for hypertension
- PMH: unremarkable
- DH: ASA 80 mg 0D
- Ph. Exam.:
 - Alert, oriented
 - BP=175/95 mmHg
 - Heart & Lung: unremarkable
